- The Clean Hands Helper collection of portable sinks was designed initially in 2010 to meet the demand for hand washing in rooms without plumbing. This product continues to help schools and daycares meet standards and achieve certification requirements associated with sanitation and hand washing.

- Intensifying cleaning protocols and adding cleaning staff
- Continuing to use healthy hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette
- Locating hand sanitizer stations throughout the plant
- Following the CDC recommendations and encouraging employees who feel ill, have a family member who feels ill, or are exposed to those who have a compromised immune system to stay home
- Requiring any employees who have travelled to self-quarantine for 14 days.
- Requiring those who can work from home to do so
- Staggering break and lunch times to reduce the number people in a shared space
- Providing masks for all employees
- Holding virtual meetings instead of in-person meetings
- Increasing workers' pay during the state's Executive Order to support the entire staff including those whose family members may be unable to work during this emergency time period.
